Session Type	Notes
Group Membership - Fully Self-Sufficient. You have sufficient permit holders within your own group to run activities independently, including safety boat cover (no help from the booking secretary to staff your sessions).	£200 per year plus £2 per young person per session. Boat park fees included. Ask the booking secretary for available session dates - Wednesday- Sunday.
Water Activity Session - Weekday evening. You have no permit holders within your group, or you have some permit holders but not enough to run fully self-sufficient safe sessions.	£10 per young person – Wednesday-Friday, Monday-Tuesday by agreement. Time on the water is dependent on daylight. Normal start time is 1830.
Water Activity Session - Weekend. You have no permit holders within your group, or you have some permit holders but not enough to run fully self-sufficient safe sessions.	£10 per young person, per 2hr session 1000-1200 or 1300-1500 Ask the booking secretary if you would like to book out the full day.
RYA Powerboat L2 course (2 days)	£100 per participant (includes certificate). Must be age 16+ on date of course.
RYA Youth L1+L2 Sailing Course RYA Youth L3+L4 Sailing Course	£50 per participant (includes certificate). Ideal course for Scouts/ Guides wanting to learn how to sail.
RYA Adult L1+L2 Sailing Course RYA Adult L3+L4 Sailing Course	£50 per participant (includes certificate). Ideal course for Explorers/ Rangers/ Leaders wanting to learn how to sail.

FAQ's

Why has a weekday evening charge gone up to £10pp?

2023 was an experimental year for WSSC and the first time in over 3 years that we have been able to run for a full season. The feedback from our permit holders was that participants on a weekday evening session are getting just as much time on the water as a weekend session and the same amount of fuel is being used for the safety boats as a weekend session.

Is it still £10pp for my Beaver section sessions even though a Beaver might only get 1hr on the water?

Yes, it is. Beaver water activity sessions run on a 1:1 ratio normally in the bell boat. The £10 covers the beaver and the parent/guardian.

My section meets on a Monday or a Tuesday but WSSC is used by the Sea Scouts on these evenings. I can't change my group night but I want to book a session. Am I excluded?

No, you are not excluded. We want all groups to be able to use Reva. Please try and change your section meeting night for this one week to Wednesday, Thursday or Friday, but if you can't change your meeting night Lisa will approach the Sea Scout leaders with the request to see what they are planning on that evening. Quite often, the Sea Scouts can meet earlier to free up the changing rooms or do a different activity to try and accommodate your booking for this one week. Please bear in mind however that where several groups all expect the Sea Scouts to free up their pre-booked evenings, the cumulative effect of this severely disrupts their summer programme.

I am a volunteer permit holder and I would like to use Reva to practice my skills. Can I use Reva when it's not in use?

Yes, we encourage volunteers to practice skills. Please note, Reva is a Scout activity centre and not a private sailing centre, so scouting activities take priority. The ASU are looking at running sessions in 2024 on a Sunday maybe once a month to allow volunteers to practice skills such as bell boating, rafting, sailing and powerboating.
