**\*\* Please note, if you enquire about group membership, and your group has 2 Scout troops or 2 Cub packs etc. you will be required to take out 2 group memberships. A group membership covers 1x Beaver Colony, 1x Cub Pack, 1x Scout Troop, 1x Explorer Unit\*\***

### FAQ's

#### **Why has a WAS charge gone up to £12pp for weekend and evening sessions?**

Unfortunately everything has gone up, incl. fuel prices for our safety boats and our rates. We have tried to keep our pricing in line with other Scout Water Activity Centres.

#### **Is it still £12pp for my Beaver section sessions even though a Beaver might only get 1hr on the water?**

Yes, it is. Beaver water activity sessions run on a 1:1 ratio normally in the bellboat. The £12 covers the beaver and the parent/guardian.

#### **My section meets on a Tuesday but WSSC is used by the Sea Scouts on these evenings. I can't change my group night but I want to book a session. Am I excluded?**

No, you are not excluded. We want all groups to be able to use Reva. Please try and change your section meeting night for this one week to Monday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday, but if you can't change your meeting night Lisa will approach the Sea Scout leaders with the request to see what they are planning on that evening. Quite often, the Sea Scouts can meet earlier to free up the changing rooms or do a different activity to try and accommodate your booking for this one week. Please bear in mind however that where several groups all expect the Sea Scouts to free up their pre-booked evenings, the cumulative effect of this severely disrupts their Summer programme.

#### **I am a volunteer permit holder and I would like to use Reva to practice my skills. Can I use Reva when it's not in use?**

Yes, we encourage volunteers to practice skills. Please note, Reva is a Scout activity centre and not a private sailing centre, so scouting activities take priority. The committee are looking at running sessions in 2026 on a Sunday to allow volunteers to practice skills such as bellboating, rafting, sailing and powerboating.

#### **I am enquiring about bringing my young people to Reva and am fully self-sufficient in terms of permit holders but I do not have group membership. Is the charge still £12 per young person?**

Yes, the full price of £12 per young person still applies, unless you have group membership.
